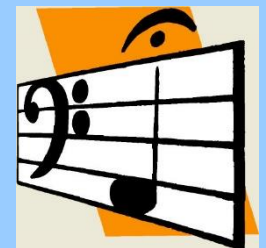
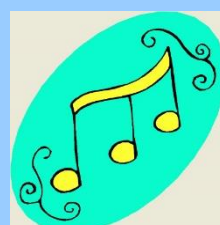
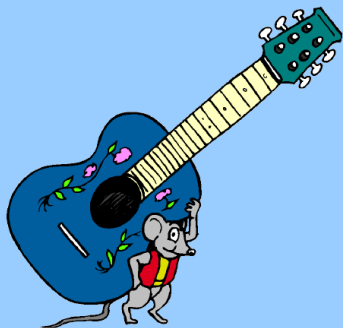
Gospel Singing

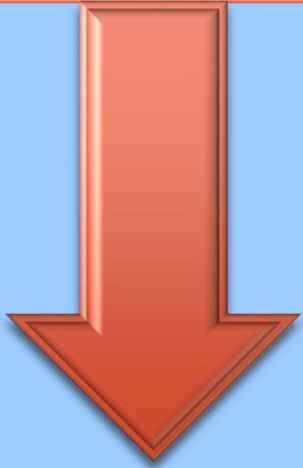
