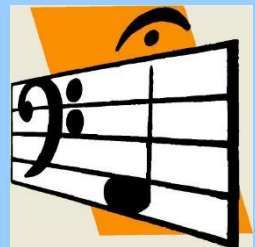
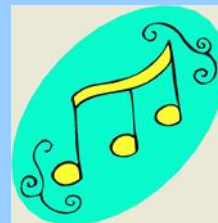
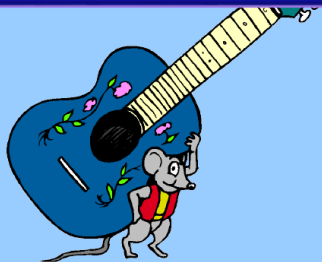
Gospel Singing

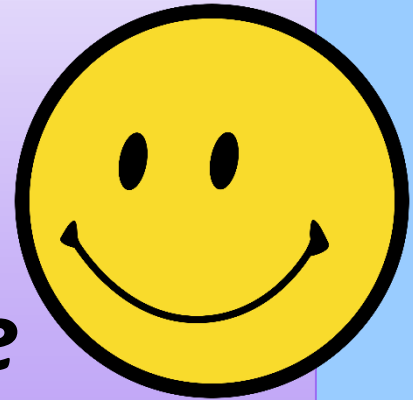

Time to enjoy the memorial gardens (weather permitting)

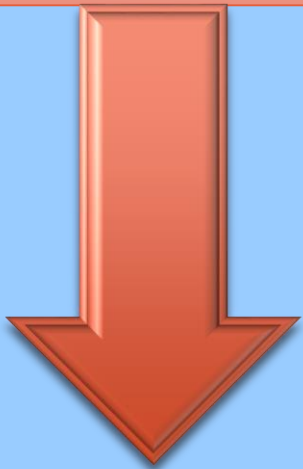
